

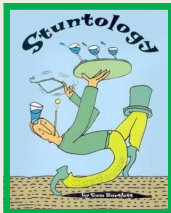
2017 SUMMER SCIENCE CAMPS



Summer Science Camp is an interactive, FUN experience, designed for children to explore different areas of science through hands-on experiments and demonstrations. All camps are for children entering kindergarten through fourth grade in Fall 2017, except as noted. Camps meet weekly, Monday-Friday, from 8 a.m. to Noon, and all of the activities are supervised by experienced staff and camp counselors.

Stuntology Camp

Micro-Macro Camp

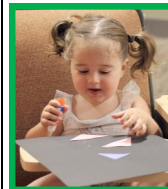
